2016 Lynx Blanc de Noir Franschoek, South Africa

For those of you looking for a light wine that is clean, crisp and dry, something perfect for all kinds of venues, either with food or on its own, then look no further than the 2016 Lynx Blanc de Noir. Made from 100% Merlot this pale pink, salmon colored blush wine has become somewhat of a cult wine in its native South Africa, as well as in Europe. Here in the US we have had great success as well, as people love its delicate strawberry fruit and lovely lingering finish, making it a delight to drink.

2016 Tyrrell's Semillon Hunter Valley, New South Wales, Australia



When one thinks of wines and the Hunter Valley, you think of Semillon. Tyrrell's has a long and illustrious history of working with the varietal. The just released 2016 Tyrrell's Semillon does a beautiful take on the varietal, with its classic citric edged fruit, but here the vintage has made it a bit more approachable, with more mid palate flesh without any loss of the requisite acidity, making it a given for a long life. **\$14.99 ea. / 6 btl. \$13.49 ea.**

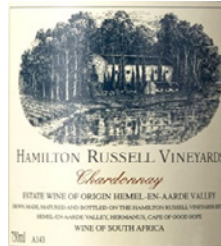
2016 Jim Barry Watervale Riesling Clare Valley, South Australia



The Watervale Riesling from Jim Barry is sourced from the Florita vineyard, renown for producing some of Clare Valleys and Australia's greatest Riesling for decades. The 2016 Watervale Riesling is exceptional, laced with classic lemon/lime fruit and riveting acidity, the finish is bone dry, with a stony minerality that says this should age brilliantly.

2016 Hamilton Russell Chardonnay Hemel-en-Aarde, South Africa



Being able to consistently produce one of the New World's finest Chardonnay that closely mirrors the finest out of France is no easy task, but Hamilton Russell keeps producing one of the best value and compelling Chardonnay you will find anywhere. Bight, lifted and linear with mineral infused fruit, this shows a great sense of place.

2016 Colome Torrontes Salta, Argentina



Always a terrific example of the varetial this new release seems to have stepped up its game. Sourced from 50 year old vineyards, grapes were picked in several stages to insure ripeness as well as acidity for freshness. The end result is a wine with classic floral overtures and bright lifted fruit, perfect for the warmer months in front of us.

**2013 Terra Noble Reserva Pinot Noir
'El Algarrobo Vineyard' Casablanca Valley, Chile**



A single vineyard offering out of Chile's cool Casablanca Valley, you would be hard pressed to find this type of quality Pinot Noir anywhere at this price. Silky and supple textured, this showcases vibrant red berry flavors with polished tannins. This has surprising depth and an impressive dry, lingering finish. This will drink impressively over the next couple of years.

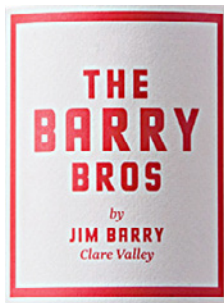
**2015 Noemia A Lisa Malbec Rio Negro
Patagonia, Argentina**



The cool southern reaches of Patagonia's climate allows for a much different style than its siblings to the north. Here the fruit is bright and lifted, in the red fruit spectrum, sleek but endowed with engaging depth and fruit intensity, with earth tones playing a beautifully balancing act to the fruit's vibrant flavors with polished tannins bringing this to a lengthy conclusion.

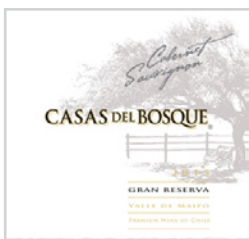
**2015 Jim Barry Barry Bros Red Blend
Clare Valley, South Australia**



Playing on the classic Aussie blend of Shiraz and Cabernet, with a small dollop of Malbec thrown in the mix, this is a gorgeous representation of the genre. Bright and lifted juicy red and dark fruits are nuanced with spice and touch of earth on the back end, while finer tuned tannins bring this to a polished conclusion.

**2015 Casas del Bosque Gran Reserva
Cabernet Sauvignon - Maipo Valley, Chile**



Winemaker Grant Phelps seems to have a knack for producing a Cabernet with some size and scale and as impressive as the previous vintage was, with its big scores, this is better. More polished and refined, this has mouth filling dark fruits on the scale of something out of Napa, but at a fraction of the price. One of the better Cabernet values we have found.

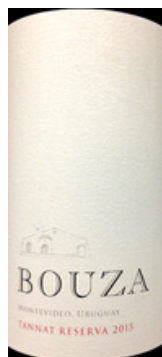
**2013 d'Arenberg 'The Custodian' Grenache
McLaren Vale, South Australia**



Delectable and downright delicious is about the only way to describe this wine. Effusive notes of lifted red fruits with a hint of earthiness define the nose, while the palate, medium fuller, is all about vibrant red fruit that is explosive in its sensory appeal. Finely tuned tannins knit it all together while the expressive fruit keeps you coming back for another glass.

**2015 Bouza Reserve Tannat
Montevideo, Uruguay**



The once unfamiliar is slowly gaining a foothold in our market. Tannat may be a somewhat obscure varietal, but a vintage like 2015 should help people wrap their heads around what this varietal is capable of offering. A core of powerful dark black fruits help counter the varietals natural gripping tannins, making this something to consider for outdoor grilling.

**2015 Anticura 'Tani Vineyard' Cabernet Franc
Vista Flores, Mendoza, Argentina**



Cabernet Franc is becoming a hot item in Argentina as producers expand their portfolios outside of Malbec. Anticura's single vineyard, high density planted, small production offering, displays deep red fruits and a spicy, peppery element reminding of red bell pepper, with no green edges. Fuller bodied and smooth textured, this has juicy mid palate fruit and a dry finish.

**2013 Bleasdale Frank Potts
Langhorne Creek, South Australia**



Bleasdale's flagship wine, named after its founder, is always a class act and represents one of the great values on a Bordeaux style red blend from anywhere. Loaded up with spicy black and red fruits, supple and beautifully balanced, slow building tannins bring this to an impressive finish. Built for the long haul, if you open in its youth, decanting is recommended.
